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Bid packages for furnishing all plant labor, equipment, materials and performing all work necessary for this project. This bid package will be available, Wednesday, April 15, 2026 and due electronically via Quest Construction Data Network (CDN) no later than **2:00 p.m., local time, Wednesday, May 13, 2026**. A pre-bid meeting will be held by Google Meet and/or by phone at 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, April 29, 2026. The site tour will be held by Maria Yang after the pre-bid meeting or scheduled appointment within 24 to 48 hours after the pre-bid meeting. Attendees are required to provide their own hard hats, safety shoes, and safety glasses with side shields.

Bid results may be publicly viewed, Wednesday, May 13, 2026 no later than 2:30 p.m., electronically on Quest CDN website, [www.veolianorthamerica.com/milwaukee/](http://www.veolianorthamerica.com/milwaukee/), or the Veolia Procurement Office, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Maintenance Building #280, located at the Jones Island Water Reclamation Facility, 700 East Jones Street, Milwaukee, WI 53207. The project contemplated herein consists of replacing the hydraulic cylinder for Gate #3. All contractor and subcontractor employees shall obtain specific site plant safety training from Veolia Water prior to working on the site. Veolia Water will offer a total of two one-hour training sessions to the contractor and any subcontractors. Safety training can also be completed online at <http://training.mmsd.com/safety-training>. The Contractor shall adhere to all Veolia Water safety policy and procedures.

Veolia has implemented online project bidding using Quest CDN. For this contract, Veolia will only accept electronic bids through Quest CDN. Bids are to be submitted online at [www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com).

The Contract Documents may be viewed and downloaded by registering with Quest CDN online ([www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com)) or calling (952-233-1632). The contract is Quest Project # 10152840. A contractor may view the Contract Documents at no cost on the Quest CDN website prior to deciding to become a Planholder. To be considered a Planholder, a contractor must register on QuestCDN.com and purchase the Contract Documents, in digital form for downloading, at a cost of \$42.00. Registering as a Planholder is recommended for all prime contractors and subcontractors because Planholders will receive addendums and other contract document updates via Quest CDN.

The time for completion of the Contract shall be two hundred and twenty-four (224) calendar days from the date of Notice to Proceed. It is important for Bidders to note that time of completion of the work under this Contract is material to its performance.

Veolia Water reserves the right to reject all Bids or any Bid or Bids not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents and to waive any informalities or deficiencies in any Bid to the extent that informality or deficiency is immaterial and promptly cured.

Veolia Water further reserves its rights to postpone the award of the Contract for a period of time not exceeding forty-five (45) days from the bid opening date. Bids shall remain firm and may not be withdrawn during this forty-five (45) day period.
